BMMHP started in year 2008 under the auspices of the Tourism Council of Bhutan (TCB) and HWZ University of Applied Science, Zurich, Switzerland. The intention behind conceiving Bhutan Middle Management Hotel Program was to provide an



opportunity for the existing hospitality personnel in the hotel industry to enhance their knowledge and skills to further professionalism and to be able to move up to a mid-level manager position.

The program will be held during the lean seasons of the year. Four courses of two months each are conducted, whereas two courses each year. This arrangement enables the students to be back at the hotels during the peak seasons. The classes are taught at Royal Institute for Tourism and Hospitality (RITH).

While BMMHP invites most of lecturers from well-known universities and hospitality sectors around the world with a plethora of experiences and distinguished careers, the Bhutanese experts will provide local expertise and skills whenever feasible and desirable.
